In October, Autodesk recognized the challenge and developed Fusion for Chromebooks solution, at no cost, to support education customers. This means, anyone with verified education license, and on a Chromebook, can access Fusion 360 on browser. But they did not stop there: Autodesk Fusion 360, the integrated 3D CAD, CAM, and CAE tool of choice in education and industry, is now available as a web app for all students and educators – no download required. In a move to promote equality of opportunity and access to technology, Autodesk is making Fusion 360 available on all devices with a modern browser. The move marks a continued push for accessibility in the Autodesk Education Community, following the widespread success of Fusion 360 for Chromebooks.
