El Camino Community College is leading a project to place community college student interns and faculty externs with U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) Small Business Innovation and Research (SBIR) firms to assist them with cybersecurity readiness/compliance.

This project will team students and faculty from the information communications technology (ICT) discipline to work with SBIR firms. Twenty (20) student interns coached by ten (10) faculty from community colleges across California will be matched with ten (10) SBIR firms.

Student internships and faculty externship stipends are funded by a The U.S. Department of Defense Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation (OLDCC) grant through the California Governor's Office of Planning and Research (OPR). The Foundation for California Community Colleges (FCCC) acts as the employer of record and handles all the payroll and workers compensation for the student interns.
